How the Tax Credit Works...

Anyone who pays state taxes may be eligible for the tax credit, which helps the children and teens in the Boys & Girls Clubs of the East Valley's programs and offers a benefit to the donors.

For example:

If you owe \$1,000 in state income taxes and you donate \$400, then you may be able to subtract the \$400 from your tax bill and pay the state only \$600. If you are owed a refund of \$1,000 for example, you may be able to add \$400 to that and obtain a refund of \$1,400.

TAX DEADLINE

If you make a donation to the Guardians for Kids/Mesa Arts Academy Tax Credit Program, it must be received in person by December 31, 2011 or if mailed, postmarked by December 31, 2011 to count for the 2011 tax year.
